#### Children with Speech and Hearing Problems Need Your Help



Communication disorders affect the way children talk, hear, process and understand information. Even minor problems with hearing, speech or

language during childhood can have major implications on their journey through life, especially if the problem goes undiagnosed and untreated.

Speech Pathologists and Audiologists can help reduce this impact. They have the expertise to minimize or remediate many communication disorders. Unfortunately, not all Virginia families are able to get their children the help they need because of the cost, however.

#### Making Testing and Treatment Possible for All

Families who do not have insurance or whose insurance has denied treatment are unable to get their children the help they need. At the SRCLC, they can apply for financial assistance, making testing and treatment accessible once again.



#### **Sponsor-a-Child Program**

When you sponsor a child, you pay a portion of the cost of his/her treatment.
With your help, the child is able to receive the life-changing services he/she needs.

# How Does the Sponsor-a-Child Program Work?

Sponsors select a level of giving. Payments can be made in installments.

One Month Sponsorship \$360 (Speech therapy for 4 weeks)

Three Month Sponsorship \$1,080 (speech therapy for twelve weeks)

Six Month Sponsorship \$2,160 (speech therapy for 24 weeks)

One time or monthly donation

Sponsors learn about their child and the communication disorder he/she struggles to overcome. As a sponsor, you'll receive reports from the child's therapist periodically, updating you on the progress he/she is making.
